GDF SUEZ Subsidiary Renews Contract with the City of Dallas for Its Total Energy Load

City of Dallas Cites Energy Provider's Quality Service and Financial Strength

HOUSTON – October 29, 2008 – SUEZ Energy Resources NA, the retail energy business of GDF SUEZ Energy North America, announced today that the City of Dallas has chosen the company to provide 100 percent of the City's electricity for municipal needs through December 2010. Similar to SUEZ Energy Resources NA's initial one-year contract with the City, 40 percent of the energy supply will be sourced from renewable energy, primarily wind.

"With the current market environment, finding a provider that we know will be financially strong going into the future was particularly important," said Jack Ireland, Director of Equipment and Building Services, for the City of Dallas. "The City was looking for someone who could offer price transparency and provide quality service with a solid financial history, and the GDF SUEZ group meets all of these qualifications. We've been extremely pleased with the partnership we've had with the company thus far, and we are happy to extend it."

Providing 100 percent of the City's load, SUEZ Energy Resources NA will supply nearly 2,500 City of Dallas meters with an estimated peak demand of 225 MW in the Oncor territory. SUEZ Energy Resources NA will continue to supply electricity to the City's facilities where usage is typically high, such as office buildings, the convention center, and water utilities, as well as the City's non-demand meters, such as street lights and traffic lights. Under the renewed contract, SUEZ Energy Resources NA will also supply energy to new meters not covered in the original arrangement. As part of its contract with SUEZ Energy Resources NA, the City of Dallas will receive 40 percent of its supply in the form of renewable energy, a critical component to the City when it initially signed with the company in 2007. In fact, the City of Dallas is among the largest municipal purchasers of clean, green energy in the country.

"We are very pleased that the City of Dallas elected to renew its contract with us," said Craig Sutter, Senior Vice President of Sales, SUEZ Energy Resources NA. "We pride ourselves on the quality of our products and services, and it is because of these strengths that our track record is strong, the City of Dallas continues to look to SUEZ Energy Resources NA for the City's electricity needs, and the number of our municipal customers continues to grow."

SUEZ Energy Resources NA currently serves commercial and industrial customers in 10 states: Delaware, Texas, Massachusetts, Maine, Maryland, New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Illinois, Connecticut and also Washington, D.C. The company serves approximately 30,000 customer accounts, mainly with commercial and industrial customers having peak demands ranging from 50 KW to more than 200 MW, for a total contracted load of 5,500 MW.

SUEZ Energy Resources NA is a subsidiary of GDF SUEZ Energy North America, Inc., which manages a range of energy businesses in the United States, Mexico, and Canada, including electricity generation and cogeneration, natural gas and liquefied natural gas (LNG), asset-based trading and origination, and retail energy sales and related services to commercial and industrial customers.

GDF SUEZ Energy North America owns and/or operates a total of 63* power, cogeneration, steam, and chilled-water facilities, including those in construction, representing a capacity of 7,400* MW of electricity generation, 6.0 million pounds per hour of steam, and 41,973 tons per hour of chilled water. The company's wholly owned subsidiary, Distrigas of Massachusetts, owns and operates an LNG receiving terminal in Everett, Massachusetts, which began operations in 1971 and currently serves most of the gas utilities in New England and key power producers, meeting approximately 20 percent of New England's annual gas demand. In addition, GDF SUEZ Energy North America has an offshore LNG import facility under construction off the coast of Massachusetts and another offshore LNG import facility under development off the coast of Florida.
